

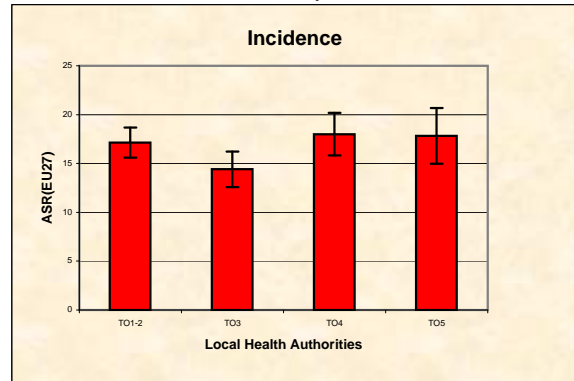

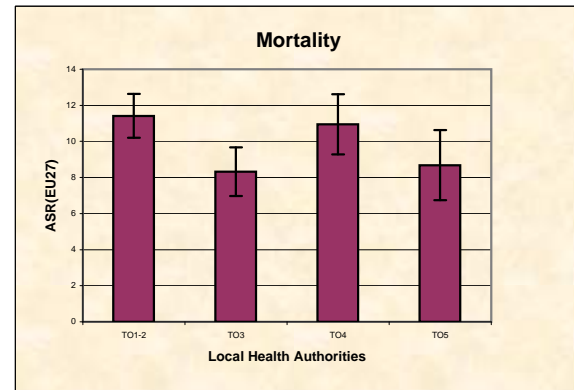

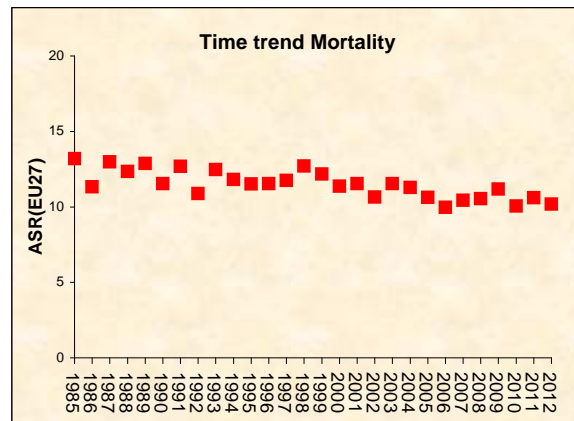
Ovarian cancer occurrence is rather stable, with a slight but constant decrease of mortality paralleled by an increase in survival, even if at 5 years it does not exceed 40%. Significant geographical variations have not been observed.
